181. DISCIPLINE - VISITS TO MALACCA

Until further notice any tasks of an official and essential nature e.g. those which cannot be completed by phone or mail, requiring visits to MALACCA WILL be permitted if a certificate is obtained from the ADJUTANT.

182. DUSTBINS

1. In order to help in the control of fly breeding, all dustbins will be washed after being emptied.
2. It is the responsibility of the BSM's, NCO's i/c Messes and departments to see that this is done.
3. The Orderly Offr, Orderly Sgt and Regt Police will pay special attention to cleanliness of dustbins during their tours of inspection.

183. PREVENTION OF MALARIA

1. Mosquito Nets

- a. All ranks will sleep after dark under mosquito nets including members of the guard etc.
- b. Individuals will keep nets in good repair.
- c. Between reveille and retreat nets will be hung above beds and not rolled up.
- d. Nets will be set up and tucked in before dark.
- e. BC's will arrange for nets to be inspected once each month.
- f. Individuals will be advised not to sleep close to the net where insects can bite through.

2. Paludrine

- a. All ranks will take one paludrine tablet daily.
- b. BC's will ensure that this is done and well maintained covering all ranks including employed.
- c. Before troops go out on exercises or operations BC's will arrange for stocks to be drawn from RMO. to cover the period expected to be away. Paludrine in cellophane strips will be drawn for this purpose.
- d. Men going on duty leave or rest requiring them to be away overnight will draw paludrine before leaving.

3. Clothing

BETWEEN RETREAT AND REVEILLE WHEN WEARING UNIFORM LONG TROUSERS WILL BE WORN AND SLEEVES WILL BE ROLLED DOWN AND BUTTONED AT THE WRIST.

184. CIVILIAN CLOTHS

1. Form of plain cloths

- a. 0600 hrs - 1845 hrs - shirt, trousers, socks and shoes. Shorts may be worn instead of trousers in which case stockings will be worn in place of socks when outside the camp area.
- b. 1845 hrs - 0600 hrs - shirt, long trousers, shoes and socks a tie will be worn in those places where wearing of ties by civilians is customary.
- c. The following items of civilian cloths will not be worn outside the regimental beach area, Tee-shirts or jersey shirts, jeans, sandals which leave the toes bare.

185. DHOBI ARRANGEMENTS

1. All ranks are reminded of the dhobi arrangements in force in 26 Regt RA. There are two dhobis:-

- a. See Toh Kin - WD Contract Dhobi
- b. KD Khan - 26 Regt RA Private Service Dhobi

2. See Toh Kin - WD Contract Dhobi

- a. All ranks other than those on QM details are forbidden to enter the Dhobi Ghaut adjacent to QMs Compound. Conversely the employees of S See Toh Kin are forbidden to enter Solma Ri Lines, other than the Dhobi Ghaut.
- b. All ranks are forbidden to enter into flying dhobi arrangements with See Toh Kin and to pay money for such service.

3. KD Khan - Private Service Contractor

- a. ORs living in Solma Ri Lines are forbidden to hand in to KD Khan items of military clothing for washing. Conversely the employees of KD Khan are forbidden to accept such items.
- b. KD Khan can accept flying dhobi as follows:
 - (1) ORs living in TERENDAK Camp - articles of civilian cloths only.
 - (2) Offrs, and ORs living in qtrs, hirings and pte accomodation- items of military or civilian clothing .

4. The RSM will at frequent intervals carry out spot checks to ensure that this order is complied with.

3. The team as stated is only provisional. Personnel may challenge during training sessions.

4. Training will be carried out in every bty swimming period and all members are advised to make use of all spare time.

190. AHBS - INCREASED HOSPITAL CHARGES IN NSW

1. Consequent upon the increase in Public Hospital charges in NSW as from 1 May 63, the Committee of Management, Army Health Benefits Society has approved as a concessionary waiver of the normal probationary periods until 31 Jul 63. on all transfers of AHBS membership from schedule 'A' and 'MB' to a higher schedule. The balance of any probationary period being served by a member due to his transfer to a higher schedule will also be waived. This does NOT apply to new members.

2. The concessionary waiver of probationary (or waiting) periods is intended to facilitate the transfer from Schedule 'A' and 'MB' of any members who desire to ensure themselves for a higher hospital benefit. This concession is applicable to all members in Schedule 'A' and 'MB' but is particularly relevant to Military members whose dependants are domiciled in NSW and to civilian members who are similarly located.

3. Effective from 1 May 1963 public hospital charges in NSW have been increased as follows :-

Public Ward	-	from 44/- to 60/- per day
Intermediate Ward	-	from 71/- to 88/- per day
Private Ward	-	from 92/- to 116/- per day

4. AHBS Hospital benefits payment under the various schedules are :-

- Schedule 'A' - 38/- per day (including 20/- per day Commonwealth benefit)
- Schedule 'MB' - 56/- per day (including 20/- per day Commonwealth benefit)
- Schedule 'MBX' - 80/- per day (including 20/- per day Commonwealth benefit)


6. A MILITARY MEMBER should contact the unit AHBS Representative (See paragraph 14 of MEI 131/61) and complete an "Application for Transfer between Schedules" (Form AHBS 12) and an "Allotment Variation Authority" (Form WF 205) to increase his AHBS Allotment by the appropriate amount. Both forms together with pay book, should be handed to the unit pay rep who when completing form WF 205 will ensure that the allotment adjustment is effective from the nearest Friday to the date of the members application to transfer. Forms AHBS 12 and WF 205 will then be forwarded to the AHBS Sub-Committee in the members command of enlistment.

Public Ward Charges - Victorian Public Hospitals

7. Advice was furnished in Military Board memo A211/1/239 of 1 March 61 that the public ward charge in VICTORIAN public hospitals was 60/- per day but the State Government had agreed to reduce this to 56/- per day for members of Health Benefit Organisations. As from the 1 Jan 63 the State Government withdrew this concession and therefore public hospital charges in VICTORIA are as follows irrespective of whether the patient is a member of a health benefit organisation or not:-

Public Ward Charges - Victorian Public Hospitals (Cont)

Public Ward	-	60/- per day
Intermediate Ward	-	72/- per day
Private Ward	-	85/- per day according to type of accommodation.



1. The MALACCA Health Authorities have agreed to a relaxation of restrictions on visiting MALACCA, in that visits will be permissible during the hours of daylight as from Monday 24 June.
2. Commencing on the 24 Jun, all ranks and their families are permitted to go to MALACCA between the hours of 0730 and 1800 each day. All who visit MALACCA under the terms of this new regulation are to be clear of the third milestone in every direction by 1800 hrs. From 1800 to 1830 hrs RMP patrols will operate to warn those who have not already left the town to be clear of the third milestone by 1830 hrs. Anyone who is found in MALACCA after 1830 hrs clearly runs the risk of having this concession withdrawn for everyone and it is, therefore, necessary that all who are in the area at 1800 hrs should be on their way back to their barracks/Quarters/Hirings/Private Accomodation.
3. All eating and drinking places remain suspect in MALACCA, therefore no uncooked food or unbottled drinks (local drinks) may be consumed and the current precautions as outlined in Instruction No 1 remain in force.

EXTRACT FROM INSTRUCTION No 1

FOOD

1. There is NO restriction on the importation of food into TERENDAK Camp of pre cooked foods. That is, food already cooked.
2. Food which is normally eaten cooked e.g. rice and meat, and which is capable of being cooked may be brought into TERENDAK Camp.
3. Food which is normally eaten in it's raw state, e.g. lettuce, tomatoes, onions and similar vegetables, will NOT be brought into TERENDAK Camp.
4. NAAFI has provided alternative sources of supply for purchasing local Asian foodstuffs both within TERENDAK Camp and at Klebang for the convenience of locally employed civilians. The RMP have orders to prohibit entry into TERENDAK Camp of all local food/drink vendors who do not comply with current restrictions.
4. A general guide regarding food is that ALL raw, uncooked and unwrapped food, including fruit, vegetables and sea food, will NOT be eaten.

196. HARDSTANDING

1. The hardstanding adjoining the LCT Landing is currently being surfaced with tarmacadam.
2. This area is Out of Bounds to vehicles until 0800 hrs 28 Jun 63

197. DISCIPLINE - STATIC VEHICLE SPEED CHECKS

1. With effect Monday 24 Jun 63, 23 COMWEL Inf Bde Gp Pro Unit will be operating static vehicle speed checks on roads within TENDAK Garrison.

2. Dvrs are reminded that speeding of vehicles has been declared a prevalent offence under PRO 88/63 (Serial 24) dated 3 Jun 63.

199. BOUNDS


Easing of restrictions TAMPIN is no longer an infected area and the town is therefore in Bounds to all military personnel and their families.
