- 1. As from the 7 Jun 63 the Christian names (or initials) of all ranks will be normally placed before the surname when reference to the officer or soldier is necessary.
- 2. The advantages of placing the surname first in nominal rolls, graduation and similar lists of names are recognised, and it is intended that this practice should be continued. However, in all other circumstances, the method laid down in paragraph 1 will be used.
